

INTERPRETATIONS
WORLD ARCHERY CONSTITUTION AND RULES

Book 3, Chapter 15, Articles 15.2.3 and 15.3.2

The Judges Committee has asked the following question: Assume that an athlete in the team round crosses the 1 meter line prematurely and the Judge then raises a yellow card, however, the athlete does not return past the 1 meter. The athlete then shoots his arrow after the expiration of time. Is a separate penalty charged for each violation?

The Constitution and Rules Committee (“C&R”) finds the question presented to be within the terms of reference of the Target Committee.

C&R has determined that the following interpretation is not contrary to the existing rules or Congress decisions.

Response from the Target Committee:

It is the decision of the Target Committee that two penalties must be assessed because they are two very distinct violations.
