

INTERPRETATIONS

WORLD ARCHERY CONSTITUTION AND RULES

Book 3, Chapter 11, Article 11.4.8.1 and Book 4, Chapter 22, Article 22.3.8.1

The German Shooting Sport and Archery Federation has asked the following question: According to an interpretation of the Technical Committee of August 20, 2012, the stitching is legal when it shows a pattern (long-short-long-short). Is it consequently also legal to have a pattern in different colours (e.g. yellow-red-yellow-red)?

The Constitution and Rules Committee (“C&R”) finds the question presented to be within the terms of reference of the Technical Committee.

C&R has determined that the following interpretation is not contrary to the existing rules or Congress decisions.

Response from the Technical Committee:

It is the majority decision of the Technical Committee that the stitching (thread) must be one colour. Accordingly, a tab with multiple colour stitching is not legal in the Barebow Division.
