Other athletes classified as VI2 or VI3 will not wear blindfolds. All the VI athletes are classified by specific, trained VI classifiers. Athletes with a visual impairment are classified according to the procedure laid out in the classifiers' handbook 21.5.2 This international classification card is the plastic type or the paper sheet which is issued until the plastic card is ready. 21.6.3. Wheelchair: • A wheelchair of any type (provided that it does not have more than four wheels) may be used provided it subscribes to the accepted principle and meaning of the word "wheelchair"; • No part of the wheelchair may support the bow arm while shooting; For wheelchair athletes, the sides of the back support of the chair may not be further forward than half the width of the athlete's body at each side as measured from the furthest point of the backrest.
